COVID-19: Screening Checklist for Visitors and Employees

On March 13, 2020, CMS and CDC updated guidance on restricting all ACF&SNF visitors and non-essential healthcare personnel, except for certain compassionate care situations, such as end-of-life. **ALL individuals** (staff, other healthcare workers, family, visitors, government officials) entering the building must be asked the following questions every eight (8) hours:

1.	Has this individual washed their hands or used alcohol-based hand rub (ABHR) on entry?
