

## **Visitors Expectations Fact Sheet**

- Visitors are screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to resident access and visitation will be refused if the individual(s) exhibits any COVID-19 symptoms or do not pass the screening questions.
- Screening shall consist of both temperature checks and asking screening questions to assess potential exposure to COVID-19.
- Documentation must include the following for each visitor to the adult care facility: first and last name of the visitor; physical (street) address of the visitor; daytime and evening telephone number; date and time of visit; and email address, if available.
- representatives from the long-term care ombudsman program (LTCOP) shall not be required to schedule visits.
- At no time shall the total number of visitors exceed 10 % of the in-house resident census
- Visitation should be limited to outdoor areas, weather permitting, who are appropriately socially distanced and wearing a facemask or face covering while in the presence of others.
- Visitors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Visitors must wear a face mask or face covering which always covers both the nose and mouth when on the premises of the ACF.
- Visitors must maintain social distancing
- Facilities will provide alcohol-based hand rub, consisting of at least 60 percent (60%) alcohol, to residents, visitors and representatives of the long-term care ombudsman prior to visiting the residents. Rub hands together using friction.
- Visitation hours are by appointment only. A copy of the ACF formal visitation plan is posted on the website and broadcasted via email. Visitation appointments are available weekly M, W, Th, Fri between the hours of 10am-3:50pm with 20 minute intervals. We will do our best to accommodate special requests for visitation as well as schedule visitation on weekends. - The staff is required to monitor the visitation process. If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.
- No consumption of food or drink will be allowed during the visit.
- No packages of any kind may be given to residents during visit.
